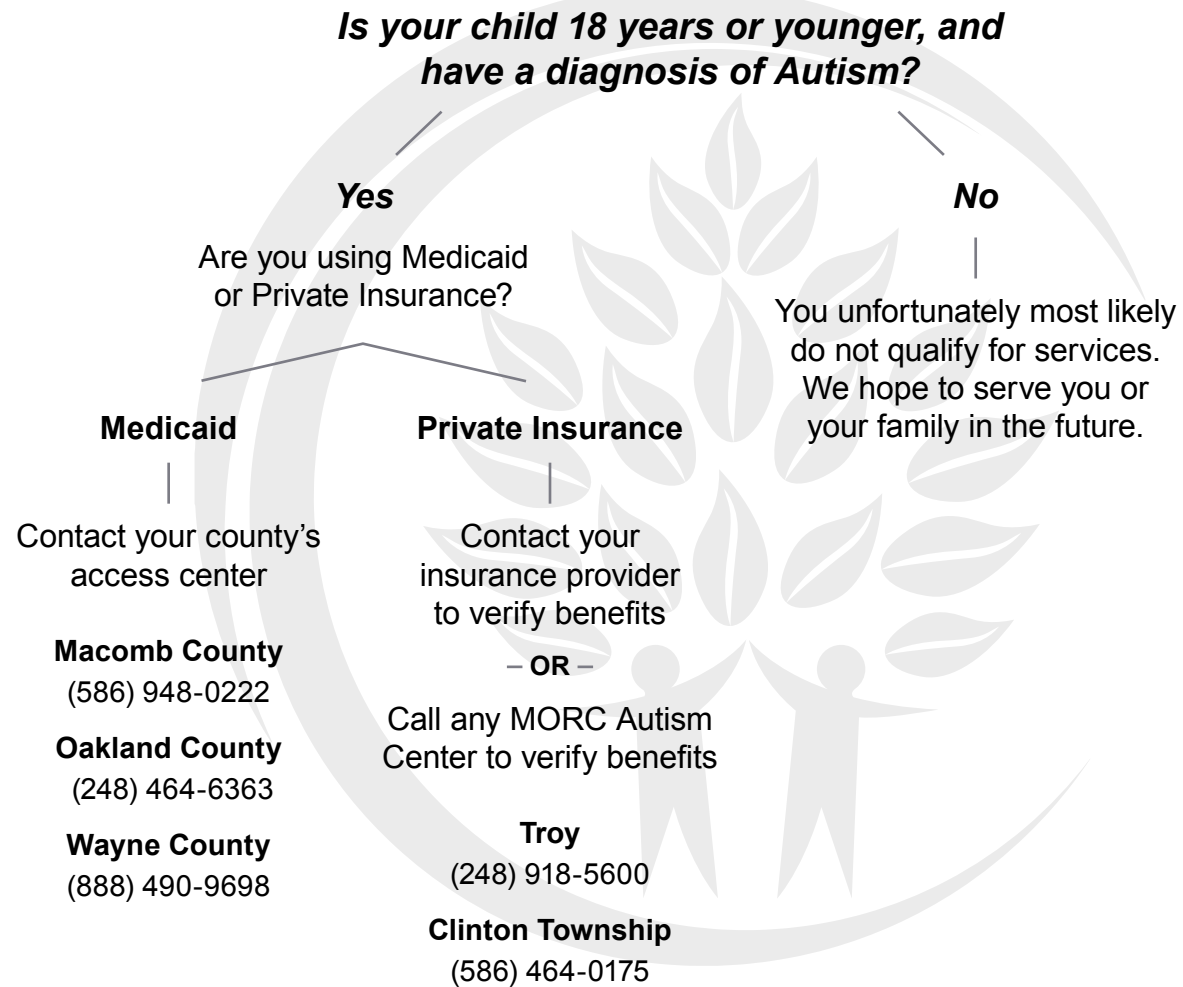

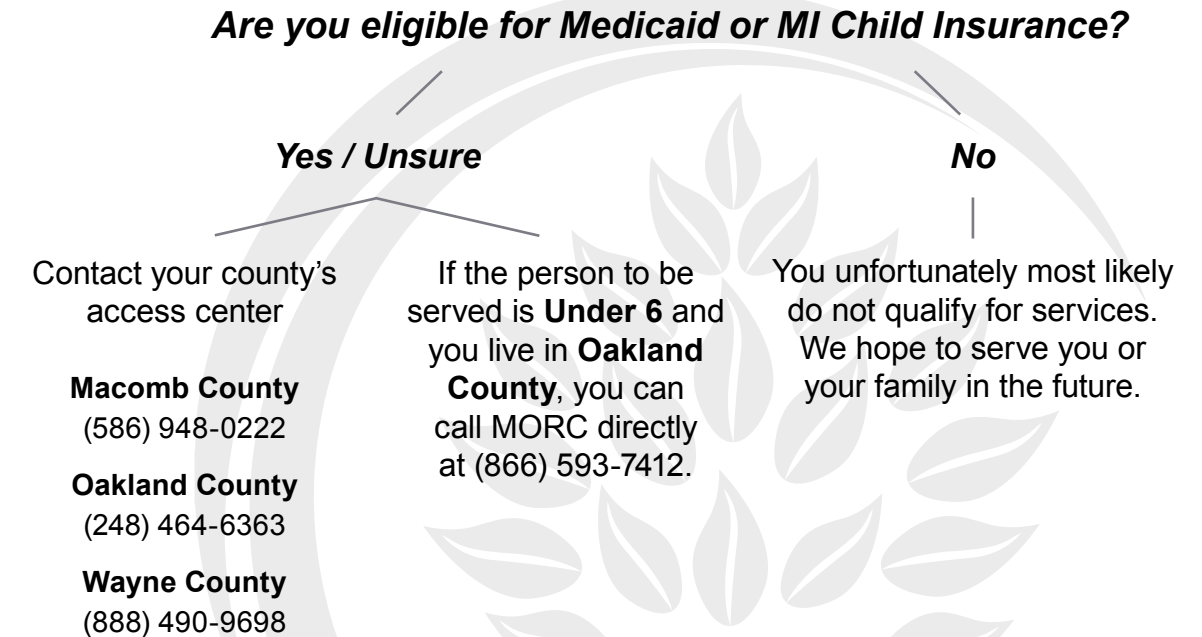

What Can A Peer Mentor Do For Me?

- Help you advocate for things that are important to you.
- Assist in creating your Care Plan.
- Help you complete benefits paperwork and navigate the insurance system.
- Help you through residential, educational and employment transitions.
- Identify community resources that help you be more independent.
- Lead self-determination efforts.
- Provide encouragement, support and shared experiences.
