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2. You are told that Shay has a communicable disease.

a. Illustrate the Chain of Infection and describe how an understanding of each link can help reduce the risk of spreading this disease.

b. Explain what the Incubation Period is:

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3. Susan is eating a piece of chicken and begins choking. You perform Abdominal Thrusts and after the second attempt the chicken is dislodged and she appears to be fine.

a. What action needs to be taken?

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4. A co-worker suspects Mary has a respiratory infection.

a. What signs and symptoms could this include?

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b. Confirming these symptoms, how do you respond?

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5. After reading Terry's IPOS, you learn that he has a high risk for skin breakdown.

a. What signs and symptoms could this include?

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b. What actions can you take to help reduce the risk for Terry?

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6. You have learned that Amari has a history of Chronic Pain and that he is nonverbal.

a. What things may you observe that indicate pain, and how should you respond?

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
