PREVENTION & DIVERSION

Interventions at the time of arrest or initial detention through Jail Diversion Coordinator services, as supported by the SIM. Focus on importance of provider's crisis management and intervention and information sharing for best outcomes.

PRETRIAL & INITIAL DETENTION COORDINATION

November 13, 2020 | 10:30 am – 11:30 am

Provider notification and information sharing for individuals who face criminal charges, obtaining court process, and pre-disposition hearing information. Adult Treatment Court and Mental Health Court for individuals charged and sentenced to probation. Identification of individuals in jail with mental health and substance use disorders.

RE-ENTRY AND COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS

December 10, 2020 | 10:30 am – 11:30 am

Learn about crucial services such as pre-release mental health screenings and community resources. Critical roles in the jail and community who provide support to individuals pre-release and through probation and parole.
